# Bordeaux

All red Bordeaux is a marriage (often a *ménage à trois*) of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot & Cabernet Franc. Entry level wines with simple Bordeaux or Bordeaux Supérieur appellations are produced throughout the Gironde département. On the left bank of the Gironde, i.e. the Médoc and Haut-Médoc, Cabernet-Sauvignon sets the tone with wines of finesse and structure. On the right bank, notably St-Emilion and Pomerol, Merlot calls the shots with wines of a more muscular and hearty style.

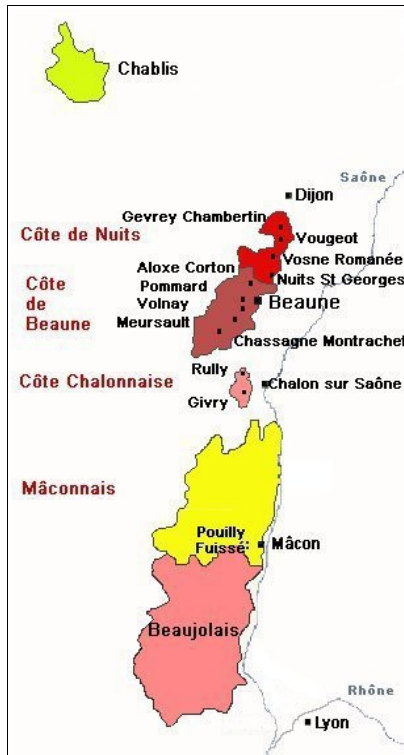


A gem of a property in the St Emilion satellite of Montagne, Château MONTAGUILLON regularly conjures up quality well above average.

# Burgundy & Beaujolais



In a region of infinite complexity, the one really simple factor is the range of grape varieties employed – just three, apart from a few niche items. White wines are from Chardonnay, reds are from Pinot Noir, and in the south, Beaujolais is from Gamay. Otherwise it's all about what the French call 'terroir', in effect the geology of the vineyard, in terms of aspect, slope, soil structure, altitude, and the interaction of these factors with the local climate.

Progressive and well run, the family estate of **CHATEAU DE L'HESTRANGE** 1.



Blacé, at 550 metres altitude, is one of the highest in the Beaujolais region. Their run Beaujolais

Villages is a fine expression of the Gamay grape. Pinot Noir contributes with Gamay to the delightfully bright and agile Grand Ordinaire. The range includes a Chardonnay of exemplary generosity, and a brisk and lively rosé of considerable character.

Over the years the name of **J. MOREAU & FILS** has become virtually synonymous with that of Chablis itself. Despite being a big fish in what is a necessarily small pond, Moreau makes wines which admirably capture the elusive charm of this northern outpost of Burgundy, quintessentially clean, correct and supple.

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From its offices in Beaune the house of **LOUIS LATOUR** presides over a business more than 200 years old, that now encompasses offshoots in several other French locations, as well as in the New World.

Latour Burgundies are regarded across the world as benchmark examples, and span the entire region.

As well as being négociants,

Latour are extensive owners

of some of the prime sites in Burgundy. Wines from their own Domaines are made at the Château Corton-Grancey winery, surrounded by the Grand Cru vines of Corton.

Perhaps the most famous of all charity wine auctions, **HOSPICES DE BEAUNE** began in 1443 with the construction of the iconic 'Hôtel Dieu' gothic-style hospital. The proceeds of which all benefit the new modern hospital just outside of Beaune.

Over several generations, the Labry family have passionately carved out the destiny of their family estate, at Melin, near Auxey-Duresses. 'Viticulture

Raisonnée' is the philosophy at the heart of **DOMAINE LABRY**, ensuring the close monitoring of the grapes, growth & environment. Their wines showcase finesse, generosity and richness.





# Loire Valley & Alsace



More diverse than other French wine regions, the Loire vineyards extend from Brittany and the sea in the west nearly as far as Burgundy in the east. In this relatively cool northerly climate fresh white wines predominate, notably Muscadet around Nantes in the west and Sancerre & Pouilly Fumé in the east, perhaps the finest French examples of Sauvignon Blanc. Among the reds, Cabernet Franc achieves real character at Chinon, and in Sancerre Pinot Noir steps over from Burgundy to provide the colour.



The light and off dry style of **ANJOU ROSÉ** is fresh with racy acidity and remains deservedly popular.

Chenin Blanc is the leading white grape in Touraine, notably at **VOUVRAY**, providing a deliciously off-dry style.

Made exclusively from Cabernet Franc, **CHINON** produces the Loire's most recognised red wines. Finely nuanced by it's terroir, this wines are supple and easy to drink.



At **DOMAINE DE SAINT PIERRE**, Bruno and Thierry Prieur exercise meticulous management of their 17 hectares of Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir vines. This, together with harvesting by hand and a cellar gleaming with stainless steel, ensures that their Sancerre's are always spot on for quality.



On the opposite side of the river from Sancerre, Pouilly-sur-Loire produces **POUILLY-FUMÉ** wines, also made from Sauvignon Blanc, but these tend to have more density and show a distinctive smokey 'fumé' character compared to Sancerre.

Founded in 1926 the vineyards of **JEAN GEILER** now cover more than 390 hectares in the heart of Alsace, befitting from more than a dozen different geologies and terroirs which reflect within the wines made. Now a Co-op with 36 winemaker's, they continue to make outstanding and prestigious wines from the legacy left from those before.

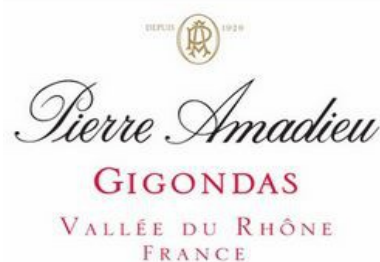

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Made from hand picked bunches of Syrah and Grenache and fermented in stainless steel to preserve the full expression of their natural fruit, AMADIEU's Côtes du Rhône wines are redolent of blackberry, blackcurrent and raspberry, with good balance and soft tannins.

The Vacqueyras has perfect poise, with greater weight and richness – fantastic quality for this price.



At a point five miles west of the Rhône and the town of Montélimar, where the Ardèche gorge reveals soils similar to those of Burgundy, LOUIS LATOUR has established a prime source of high quality Chardonnay.



# French Regional Wines

The Mediterranean coastal region of France, from the Rhône delta westwards towards Roussillon and the border with Spain, is known as the Languedoc. Extending into the lesser-known region of the South-West covers the area between Bordeaux and Languedoc. Both these regions are noted for their variety of grape usage and styles, producing eccentric standout wines.



Vineyards in Cahors

The whole operation at **CHATEAU FONMOURGUES** is managed completely by hand. Only the ripest, botrytis-affected grapes are selected; with tiny yields, quality overrules quantity. Made with classic Sauternes grapes.



Compromising of 55 hectares of vines, **CHATEAU NOZIERES**, is a fourth-generation family run estate. Cahors red wines must be at least 70% Malbec, the complementary variety added being Merlot to soften tannins.

The appellation Pays d'Oc is rather too all embracing to do proper justice to the quality of the wines of **DOMAINE BERGON**.

Situated on the coastal plain between Beziers and Montpellier, the estate produces very attractive wines of textbook varietal character and ripeness

Grown around the Bassin de Thau and the Hérault river in the Languedoc, **PICPOUL DE PINET** whites are ever-growing in popularity with their zesty, light & crisp character that pairs well with seafood.

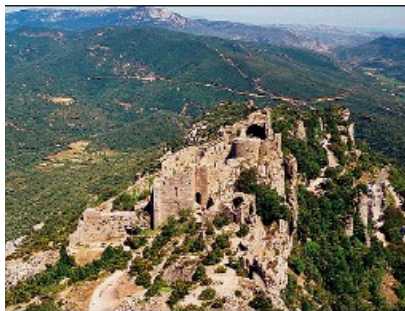

# French Regional Wines



The Minervois

Wine making in the Languedoc region can be dated back vines originally planted by the Greeks which was then further developed by the Romans. Now, it is France's largest wine producing area and accounts for a third of its wine. Providing a natural environment for grape growing, the region has benefited greatly in recent years from the widespread planting of classic varieties, and is now the source of good value wines of consistent quality.

It's 'honorary Provence' rosé's are made from a blend of Cinsault, Grenache and Syrah grapes. The domaine also takes pride in having high environmental values and have achieved French certification.

The Côtes de Provence region is known for producing outstanding rosé wines, one of the most adored is **WHISPERING ANGEL** which is the most popular rosé in the world. However, there are plenty of lesser-known rosés from Provence that have the same pale pink, delicately fruity and mineral character, such as the **MANON ROSE** that offers excellent quality without such a price tag.



# Northern Italy

To judge by this picture of the grape festooned god Bacchus, found in the ruins of Pompei, winemaking was as much part of Italian life 2000 years ago as it is today. Now, Italy is a world-leading producer and makes more wine than any other country. Each region has distinct grape varieties, wine styles and individuality, producing everything from lean, dry whites in the (relatively) cool North to fat and chunky reds in the warm South.

Sheltered by the Alps to the north and spared from the Mediterranean heat of the south, **VENETO** is the source of a host of light, fresh wines offering excellent value for money. The traditional favourites,

Valpolicella, Bardolino and Soave, have been somewhat upstaged in recent years by the popularity of Pinot Grigio. Dry, yet soft and supple, this varietal is now available also in a Blush style, both ideal as an aperitif.



**PROSECCO** Grown in the foothills of the Dolomites north-west of Venice, the sparkling wines made here are incomparably lively, refreshing and light.

The northernmost region of Trentino-Alto Adige, which was historically Austrian and thus German speaking, is home to the **WILHELM WALCH** winery. The estate, now run by it's fifth generation, puts emphasis on producing classic local varietal wines in a modern and straight-forward style whilst rounding out their selection with international varieties.

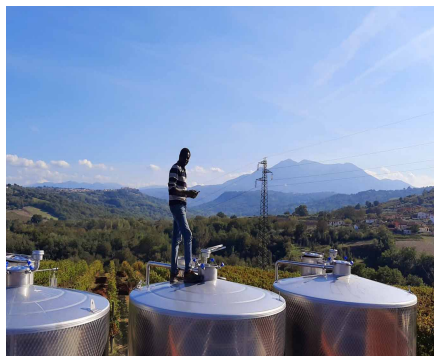

# Austria & Germany

*Roman Pfaffl has stood at the helm of his family's acclaimed wine estate for over 30 years. The dedication to quality has earned WEINGUT R&A PFAFFL a reputation as the leading winery in Weinviertel, Austria's largest and best-known wine region.*

*Located in the municipality of Bad Kreuznach in the wine-growing region along the river Nahe. The KORRELL family, originally from Spain, has been producing wine here for around 250 years and today, the 26 hectare vineyards are run by the sixth generation of the family. Making wines of sophistication straight out of a picture book with a classic Riesling offering.*



Like the Tempranillo on the Iberian Peninsula, so in Austria does the Grüner Veltliner crop up more or less every-where, and accounts for a third of Austrian vineyard plantings. Despite its ubiquity at home and its ability to produce wines of great character and style, from dry and minerally (Pfaffl) to concentrated and sweet (Hafner), only small quantities manage to evade the clutches of the Austrians and become available for export.

The privately-owned Monemvasia winery, around 30 hectares, is planted with native varieties, in an area with an interesting topography, soil and subsoil diversity, a lot of winds and a neighbouring sea.

Ancient grape varieties and modern techniques - that is the philosophy of the MONEMVASIA WINERY, set up in 1997 by George Tsimpidis with the express intention of preserving the wonderful legacy of grapes local to Laconia, the south-eastern 'finger' of the Peloponnese.

**MOSCHOFILERO**, a gray skinned variety, achieves notable delicacy and elegance, with subtle floral character on the Mantinia plateau towards the north of the Peloponnese.

**KIDONITSA** is lemony green in colour, with aromas dominated by notes of ripe quince ('Kidoni' in Greek)

**MAVROUDI** - 'mavro' = black - is in effect a generic name for vines grown all over Greece, mostly as a blending partner. Mavroudi, full, rich and dark, was reputedly used by Ulysses to befuddle the Cyclops

**AGIORGITIKO** (St. George) the great red grape of the Peloponnese is a genuinely world class variety, capable of great depth and subtlety.

Of the 5 wine growing regions in BULGARIA, 2 are classified as PGI (Protected Geographical Indication), the Danubian Plains & the Thracian Lowlands. Located south of the Balkan Mountains, bounded by the Black Sea to the east and Greece to the south, Bulgaria's **THRACIAN VALLEY** is considered by many historians to be one of the oldest winemaking regions in the world.



# Lebanon & Turkey



**Temple of Bacchus - Baalbek**



Situated on the site of a former Crusader fortress or ksar, **CHÂTEAU KSARA** is the oldest of Lebanon's wineries in the modern era. 150 years ago Jesuit monks took over the vestigial vineyards that had somehow survived centuries of Ottoman rule, and revitalised production based on the introduction of a range of noble French grape

varieties. Climatic conditions in the Bekaa provide the vineyards with exceptional advantages. The wines are aged in spacious underground galleries, in use since Roman times, where the temperature in both summer and winter varies between 11-13°C and provides the essential conditions for bringing wine to its peak of perfection.



**CHÂTEAU MUSAR's** vineyards are located at an altitude of over 3,000 feet in the Bekaa Valley where the vines are sheltered by the surrounding mountains running parallel to the Mediterranean coast. Covering 180 hectares, the grapes are transported to Ghazir on the coast, some 30 miles to the west, where vinification takes place in the cellars of the 17<sup>th</sup> century castle. Now described and known as one of the great wines of the world with its eccentric and intriguing style.



Viticulture in Lebanon was introduced 6000 years ago by the Phoenicians who traded their wines throughout the Mediterranean and planted the vine in southern Europe. Activity is centred on the Bekaa Valley in the east of the country, where the vineyards are almost frost and disease free, with long mild summers, rainy winters with an annual rainfall of 500mm, and an average temperature of 25 degrees Celsius.

**THALVIN** wine production dates back to 1968 with the acquisition of 400 hectares of vines on the Domaine des Ouled Thaleb at Ben Slimane some 30 miles from Casablanca.

# Chile & Argentina



With 2700 miles of coastline along the cool Pacific, Chile produces wines that are fruit-forward as well as herbaceous. Even though Chile is classified as a 'New World' wine region, its history tells us otherwise with the first grapevines planted in the 1500s and European immigrants bringing over more varieties, particularly from Bordeaux, in the 1800s. Chilean wines are among the most popular in the world and justifiably so, since top quality is available at exceptional value.



**VIÑA GRACIA's** vineyards are strategically located in the Chile's most important viticultural regions, assuring diversity and quality in every one of its varieties, which lends a unique identity to its wines. Each varietal is an enjoyable expression of the grape, very quaffable with attractive pricing.



Since taking over the **LOS VASCOS** estate in 1988, the iconic Domaines Baron de Rothschild, owners of Château Lafite in Bordeaux, have flourished in Chile. The wines are more European in style than most and are notable for their quality and elegance.

**BODEGAS ARGENCERES** is located at San Rafael, one of the foremost wine regions in Mendoza. # Uruguay



Sandwiched between two giants, Argentina and Brazil, Uruguay receives scant attention from the rest of the world, yet it has a wine industry to be proud of, capable of producing quality at least as good as anything coming from the Andes, over 1000 kilometers to the west. In the south of the country, near the capital, Montevideo, bordering the estuary of the Rio de la Plata, the climate is moderate and maritime, not dissimilar to that of Bordeaux.

### THE TANNAT GRAPE

19<sup>th</sup> century immigrants to South America from south west France took their local vine varieties with them. Thus Carmenère took root in Chile and Malbec found its way to Mendoza. Meanwhile the French Basques who settled in Uruguay brought their local Tannat. Plantings in Uruguay now far exceed those in France, where the variety survives as the main grape in the wines of Madiran. By nature dark and tannic, Tannat appears to ripen better in Uruguay, giving wines of a softer, riper style than in France, and though by no means lacking in structure, ready to drink much earlier.

GIMENEZ MENDEZ is an established family winery with 100 hectares of vines located in the regions of Las Brujas, Montevideo, Los Cerrillos and Canelón Grande, in the south of Uruguay, a natural area for the production of fine wines. Marta Gimenez Mendez and her two sons, Luis and Mauro, produce fine wines with a commitment to quality and excellence attainable only in a truly family enterprise. Their emphasis is on wines of balance and finesse, rather than the macho extremes of style one encounters elsewhere in the New World.

**AFRICAN TERROIR** are made at the Sonop Wine Farm at Paarl in the heart of the Cape winelands. Their policy is maximum involvement of the farm workers in all aspects of production, and these wines are some of the relatively few in South Africa to be made entirely by Africans. The organic varietal blends represent especially good value for money.



**BOSCHENDAL** is one of the oldest wine estates in South Africa, dating back 300 years when its French founders recognised the lands' potential. Today, its vision is to produce classic premium wines of unwavering exceptional quality whilst balancing tradition with contemporary innovation.

The hinterland of Cape Town is home to numerous fine wine estates which can trace as far back as three centuries, as **MEERLUST** does, which makes wines whose quality and refinement its (in many cases much younger) European counterparts can only aspire to.



**CALIFORNIA**, also known as the Golden State, is the largest wine-growing region in the US as well as impressively being the fourth leading producer in the world after France, Italy & Spain. With a long growing season influenced by ideal weather conditions, many different grape varieties are able to be grown here, producing stand-out wines.

With a history of wine making dating back to the late 1600's, South Africa is 'New World' with a very small 'n'. Many of the famous estates in the Cape have more heritage than their counterparts in Europe. Now that the straitjacket that stifled the industry during the apartheid era has gone, the country offers choice and vitality aplenty.

Lack of water is a problem, too, especially during the recent years of drought. Whilst reliability is never an issue, individuality is at risk of being engineered out of the equation at lower price levels.

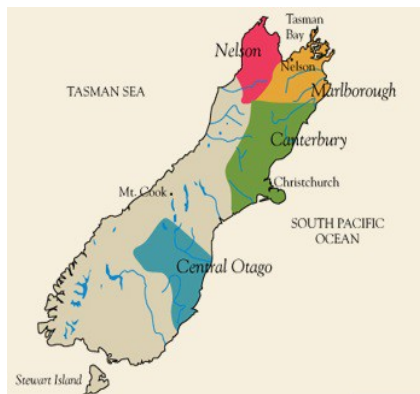

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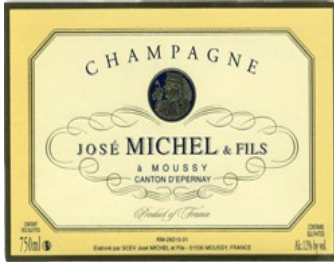

Delta, near Bangkok, provide the basis of the entry level wines, to which are added Colombard and Shiraz grown in the Hua Hin Hills to the south.

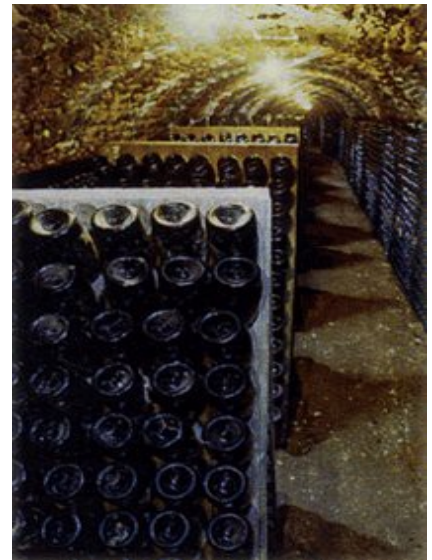

There is no true origin date of **ROSÉ** because, at the time, many reds were the colour of today's rosé wines. As fermentation methods developed, a deeper and darker red was created – which we know and enjoy today.

It was the Greeks and the Romans, who eventually figured out how to separate red wines from the whites but it wasn't until the 6<sup>th</sup> century that the Phocaeans bought grape vines to Massilia (Marseille) in the South of France, that this pink wine became and still is, the talk of the town.
